Wailea Ins and Outs

The **Andaz** project is moving along on schedule to open in March 2013. They recently completed their site work and are working feverishly on the interior as well as the outbuildings.

The **Auwahi windmill** project will only run the superloads thru Wailea during the first 3 weeks of August.

The plans for the **Piilani Highway** widening are only 35% completed so it will be some time before they begin work.

The County's **Polo Beach** access restroom is closed due to the failure of a sewage pump on the line servicing the Polo Beach Club condos and the County facility. We have been told that a new pump is on order and the restroom may be closed for 3 weeks. In the meantime the County has provided a Port-a-potty at the access.

The County Council today voted on Tuesday whether or not to approve a first reading of the **Transient Vacation bill** and pass it on to the second reading where it could be approved and become final. Members of the community are still hopeful that this can be stopped but it will still take more effort from everyone over the next month. The **Grand Wailea** received its Special Management Area approval last week on the improvements they have been seeking. Construction on some of the vital changes to restaurants and other areas may begin in about 14 months. The major work adding 280 rooms is still probably 2-1/2 years off.

The Improved Ulua Beach Park


The long awaited improvements at the Ulua Beach access is nearly complete.

Q & A From the Annual Meeting

Q: The condition of the road on Wailea Alanui is bad, can a lane in each direction be closed to add bike lanes, what is being done about the speeding on roads, and why is the light at Ho'olei so short?

A: WCA is aware of the condition of the road and has been requesting that the County place the repaving on their schedule considering it is a County Road. Public Works has indicated that it is on their radar but they may not be able to scheduled the work for a couple more years. The County has previously indicated that they do not want to add bicycle lanes to Alanui because it would dangerously narrow the existing vehicle lanes, which are necessary due to the amount of traffic in the area. The light at Ho'olei

is triggered by vehicles exiting either Ho'olei or the Grand and not on a timer. For more information please contact County Public Works at 270-7845. Besides the WCA Speed Patrol on the roads daily with a speed board, the MPD has always be made aware of the speeding issues throughout Wailea. If you would like to express your concern please contact the MPD at 244-6400.

Q: Can there be a community garage sale to sell off unwanted items? Does WCA have a location for such an event?

A: If a committee of those owners interested in making the event happen can put together a well organized event befitting of the community, WCA would support an annual "garage sale" being held in the

overflow parking lot. The committee would need to secure all the necessary information required for such an event (permits, insurance, security, charitable beneficiary, etc.).

Q: Will WCA oppose the proposed outlet mall in Kihei just south of the Shell gas station?

A: The WCA Board has determined that it is not going to take a position on this matter. The Kihei Community Association is monitoring the progress of the mall and WCA is in contact with the KCA on numerous matters.
